Queen Elisabeth II is the present head of the United Kingdom.

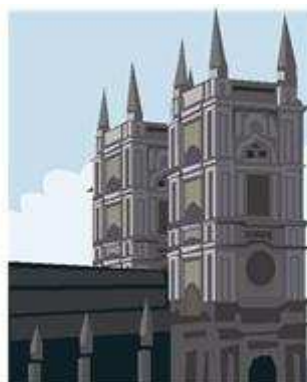
She is also the head of Canada, Australia and New Zealand.
